Descaler XL

Descaler XL is an inhibited, acidic liquid cleaner, formulated to remove sludge buildup and hard scales, from stainless steel and polymer based process tanks, spray cabinets, phosphate lines, and other metal finishing process equipment. Descaler XL will replace harsher mineral acid descaling products, and will reduce extraction of chrome and nickel from stainless alloys.

Descaler XL should only be used for equipment manufactured with 304/316 Stainless Steel, Alloy 20, or Titanium materials. It should NOT be used on other stainless alloys, or mild(carbon steel) equipment. Caution should also be used as it will etch glass, especially if allowed to dry on the surface. Do not use this product on chrome, tin, zinc, galvanized or magnesium surfaces.

Descaler XL should not be used for pre-treatment or cleaning of metal parts, but as a one time use for equipment clean out.
